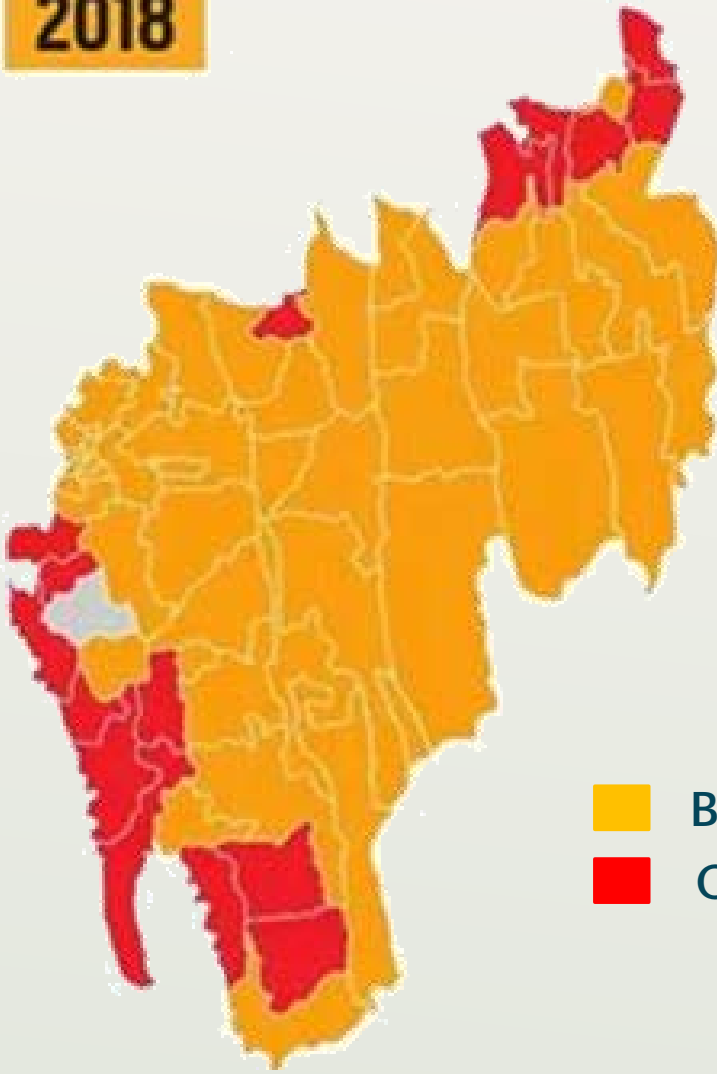

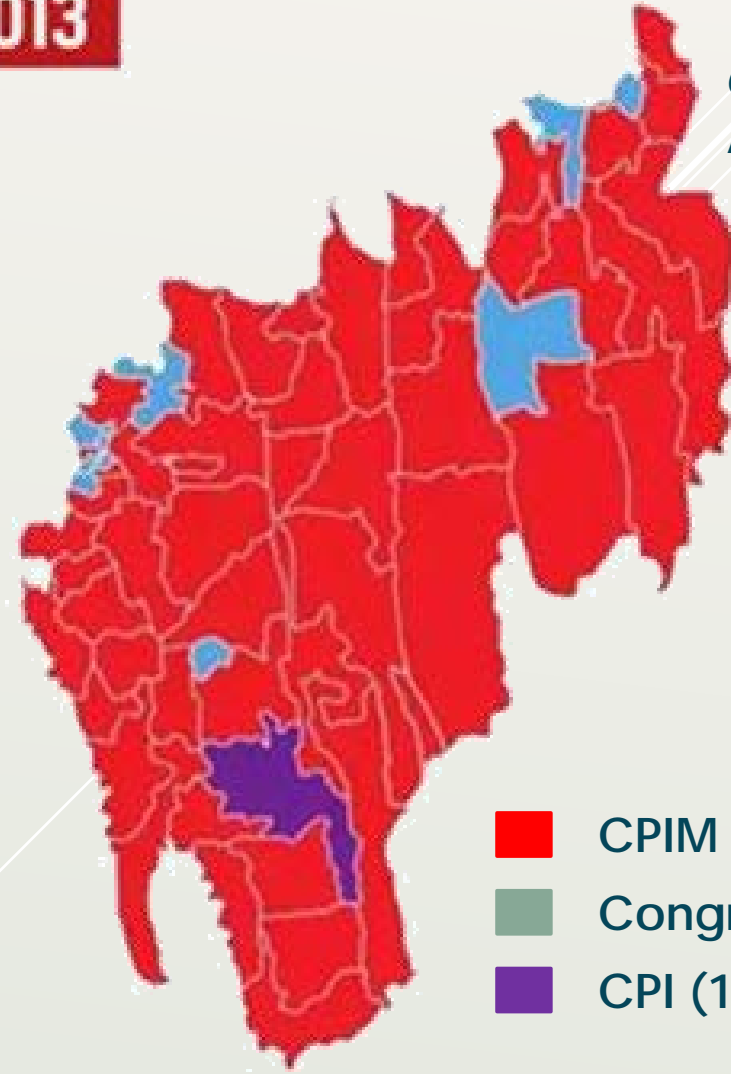

Left lost to IPFT (8 Seats)

IPFT snatched 8 ST Reserved seats from Left Front, and lost only in one seat

 An overall increase of 71,401 votes; a positive voter deviation of 24.7% from Left to IPFT
