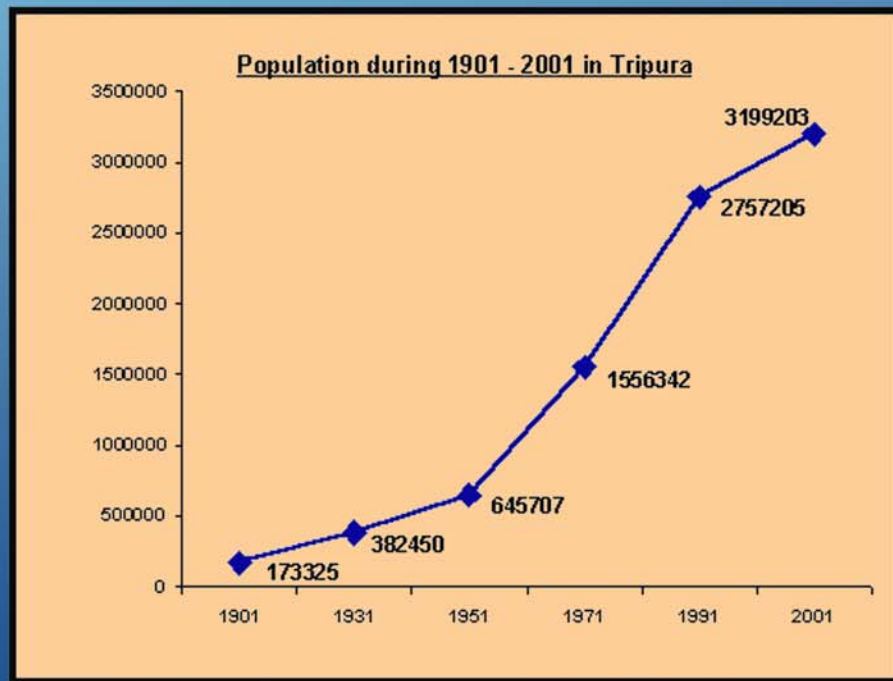

Percentage of Literates to total population, 2001

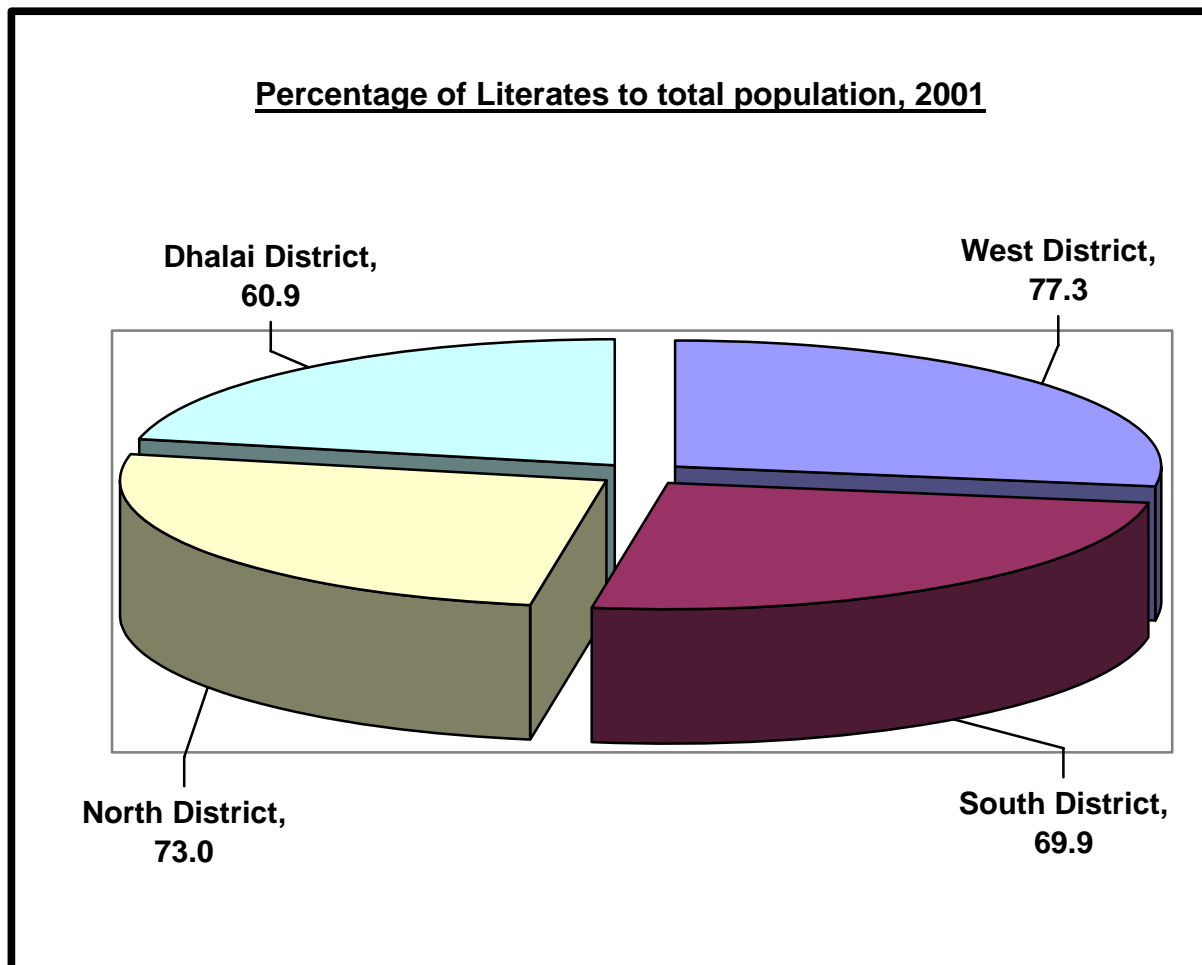

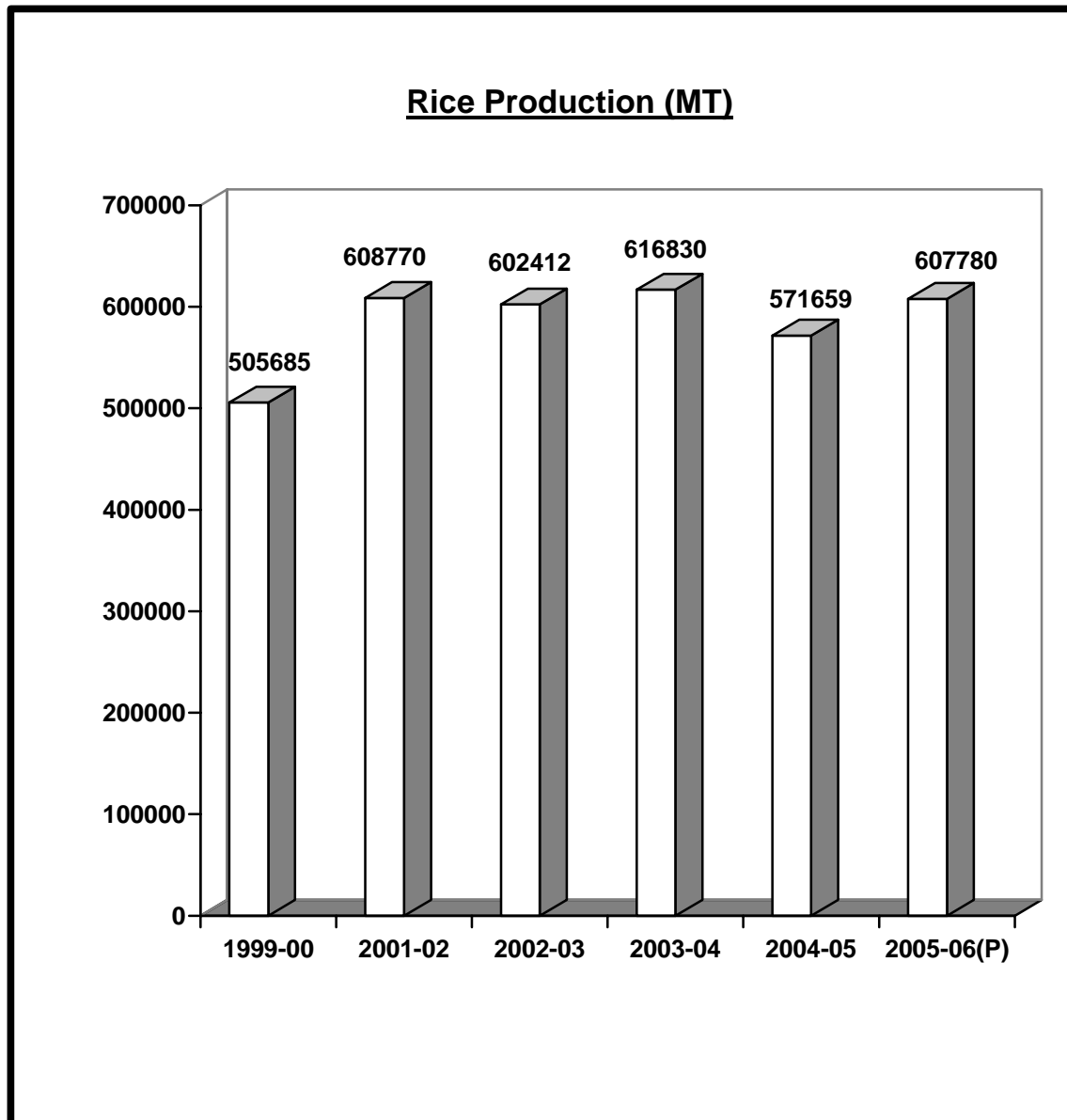

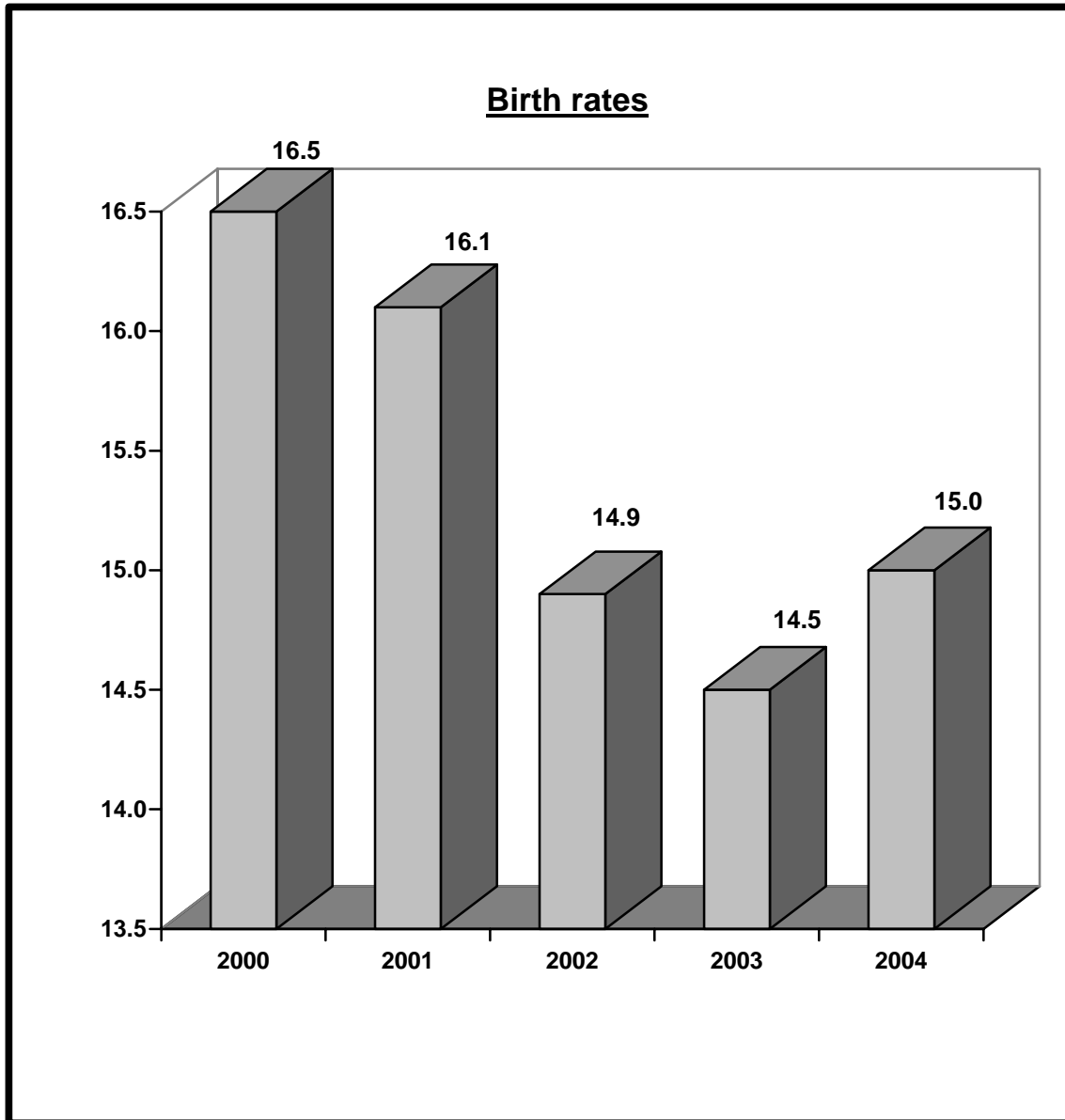

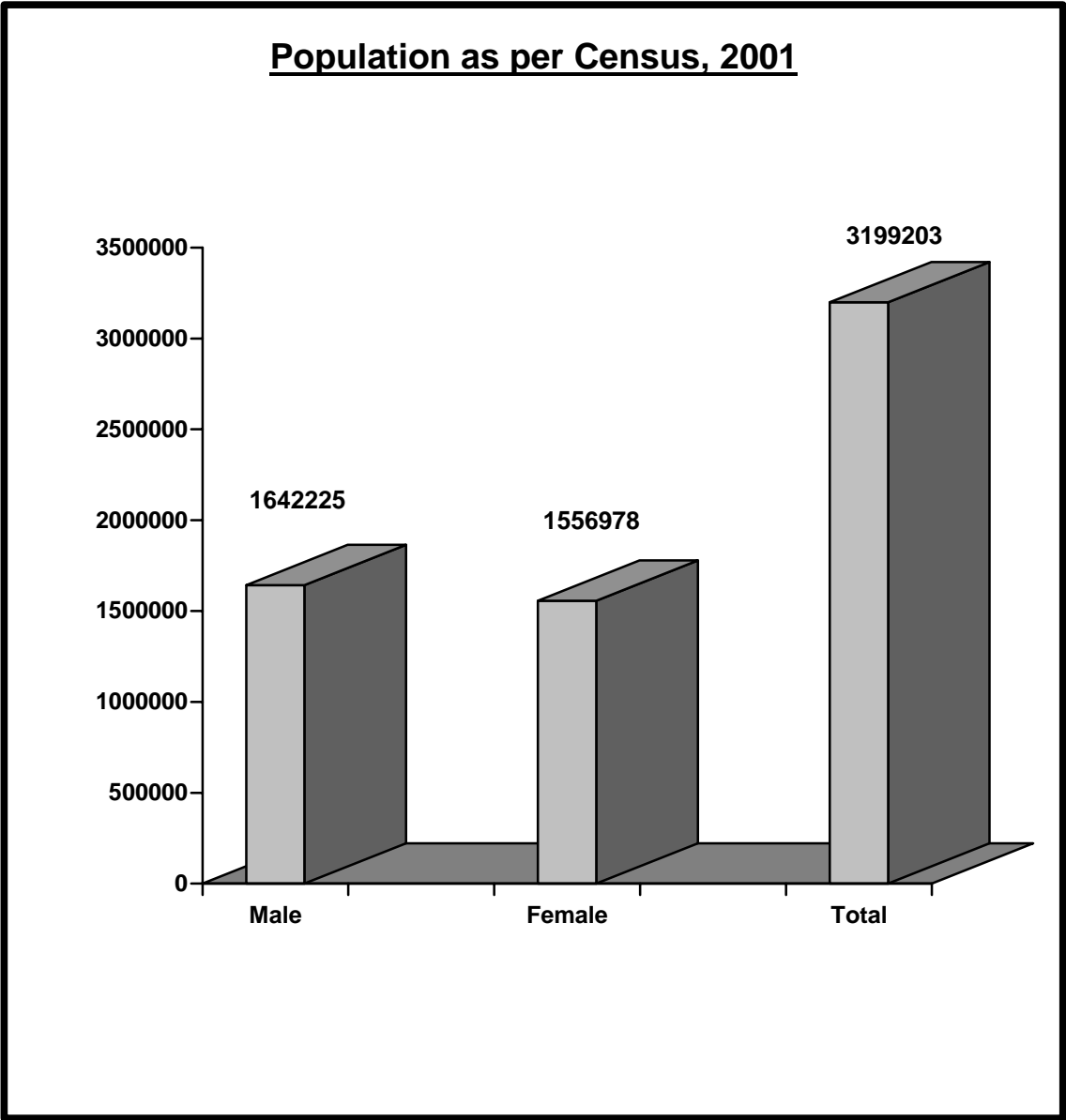
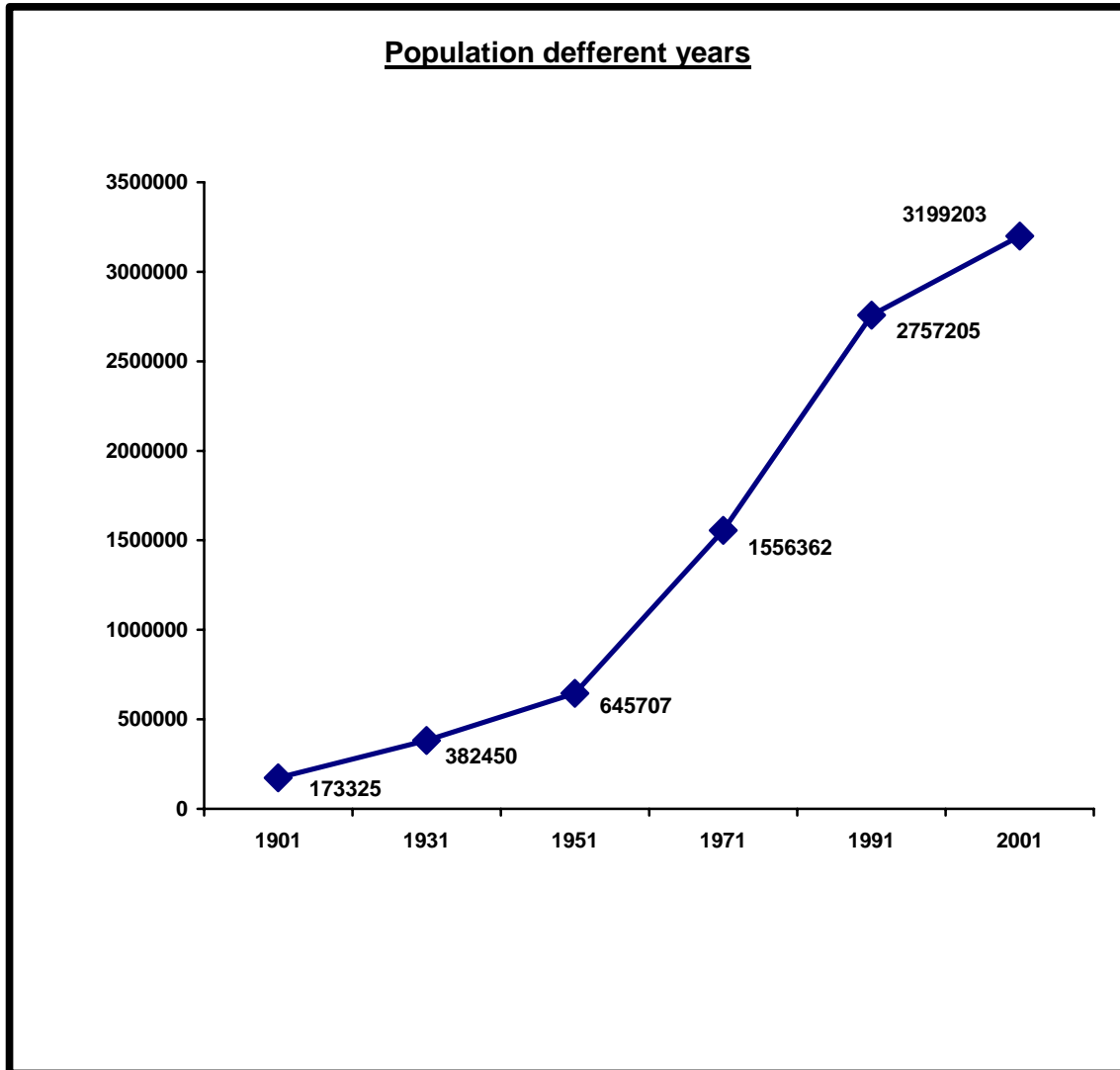

Percentage of Literates to total population, 2001

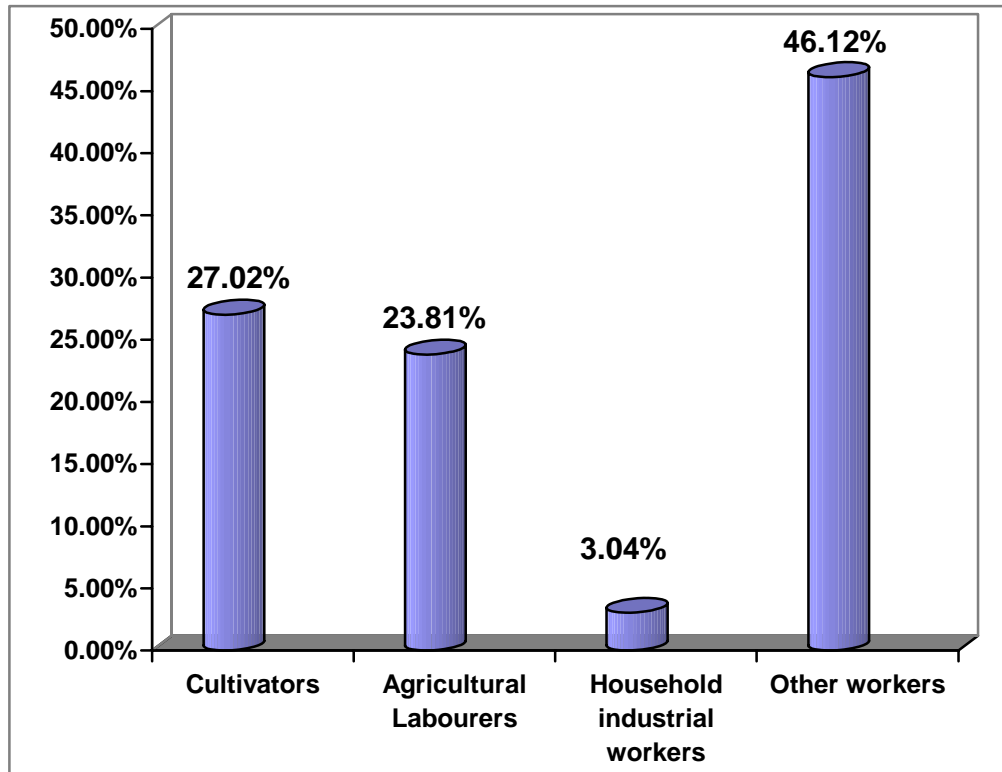
